Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment

As previously communicated, the project team will begin dredging work within the designated marine construction zone to safely remove contaminated soils. Location of dredging is shown in the attached map in yellow.

This work was originally planned from February 2-17. However, this work will now start on February 10, 2026, and is expected to be complete by February 23, 2026.

A crane barge and three additional barges to support dredging will mobilize to site on Monday, February 9. All operations will occur strictly within the established project boundary.

No impacts to surrounding marine stakeholders are expected. Barges will transit in and out of harbour no more than twice during this period and will leave early or late at night to avoid conflicts with busier marine vessel traffic times.

Timing

- Mobilization: February 9, 2026.
- Dredging: February 10 to 23, 2026.



Hours of Work

- Monday to Friday: 7 am to 7 pm
- Saturdays: 10 am to 7 pm



Traffic

- No marine traffic impacts are anticipated.

- Increased marine activity within site boundaries.
- Mobilization of barges within the existing project boundary.
