Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment

As construction of the Belleville Terminal continues to progress, the project team will begin dredging work within the designated marine construction zone to safely remove contaminated soils. Location of dredging is shown in the attached map in yellow. This work will start on **February 2, 2026**, and will take approximately two weeks to complete.

A crane barge and three additional barges to support dredging will mobilize to site on January 30. All operations will occur strictly within the established project boundary.

No impacts to surrounding marine stakeholders are expected. Barges will transit in and out of harbour no more than twice during this period and will leave early or late at night to avoid conflicts with busier marine vessel traffic times.

Timing

- Mobilization: January 30, 2026.
- Dredging: February 2 to 17, 2026.



Hours of Work

- Monday to Friday: 7 am to 7 pm
- Saturdays: 10 am to 7 pm



Traffic

- No marine traffic impacts are anticipated.



Impacts

- Increased marine activity within site boundaries.
- Mobilization of barges within the existing project boundary.
