Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment

As construction of the Belleville Terminal continues to progress, dredging will resume on May 1, 2026 and continue until the end of the month. This is the final dredging to prepare for future marine structures.

This work will require a crane barge supported by an additional barge to transport material from the harbour.

No impacts to surrounding stakeholders are expected during dredging activity.
