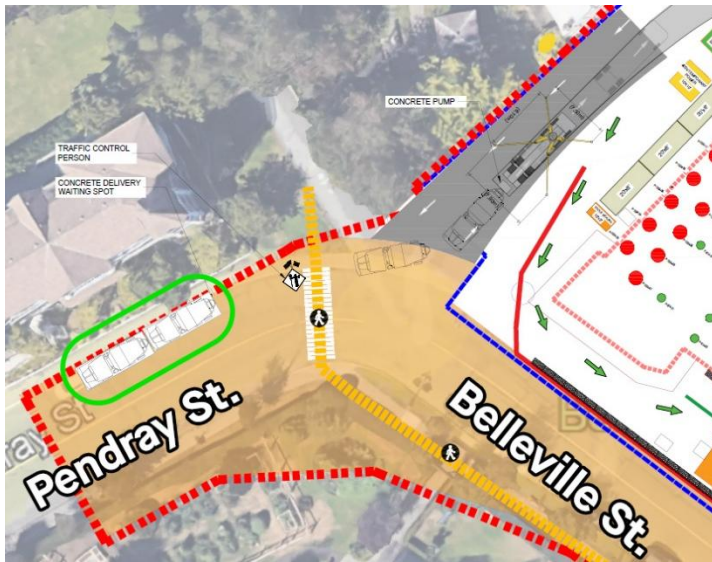

Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment



As construction of the Belleville Terminal progresses, **large concrete pours will begin on May 21, 2026**. These pours are required to form the foundation for the future Belleville Terminal building and are expected to continue weekly until the end of June 2026.

Activities will take place primarily within the site perimeter. However, on certain days there may be an increased number of concrete delivery trucks accessing the site, and trucks may occasionally stage off-site along the westbound curb lane of Pendray St. while waiting to unload (truck staging area marked green in the attached map).

We anticipate an average of two concrete pours per week, with volumes ranging from 20 m³ to 300 m³, depending on the phase of work. The largest concrete pours will require approximately 30 trucks over a period of about 10-12 hours.

Traffic control personnel will be on site to manage vehicle movements and ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians, and the public throughout the duration of concrete activities.

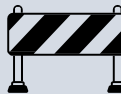
Hours of Work
