Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment

As construction of the Belleville Terminal Redevelopment Project progresses, marine piling activities are expected to begin the week of July 13th, 2026. The majority of piling will be complete in 2027, however the final piles need to be installed during the Coho dry dock period in early 2028.

This work is required to support the new wharf facility. Activities involve delivery of marine piling equipment, rebar, concrete work and intermittent piling.

Increased noise and activity in the marine piling area may be noticeable during this period, along with increased presence of marine equipment such as barges and cranes. All work will be carefully coordinated to ensure safety and minimize disruptions to surrounding stakeholders and marine users.

- Monday to Friday: 7 am to 7 pm
- Saturdays: 10 am to 7 pm



Traffic

- No significant marine traffic impacts are anticipated
- Some increase in barge traffic

- Increased marine activity
- Transit of barges to and from the site
- Increased marine piling related noise
