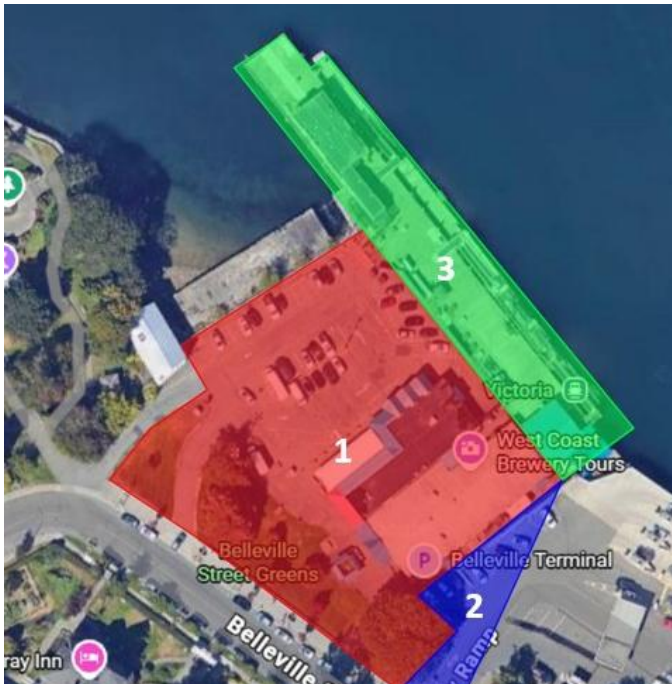

Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment



The next essential phase of project construction is **scheduled to begin the week of December 15, 2025**, with an expected completion date in 2027. This phase involves the installation of foundation piles, which are essential for the new terminal building and wharf structure.

All work will be performed within the site perimeter, as shown in the attached map. This work will be broken down into three phases: Phase 1 (shown in red) will commence in December 2025. Phase 2 (shown in blue) will commence in January 2026, and Phase 3 (shown in green) will commence in summer 2026.

Please note that piling work will be paused from December 24 to 28, 2025, and on January 1, 2026, to provide noise relief during the holiday season. Light maintenance work may be ongoing during this time.

An acoustic engineer is on the site to provide mitigation to minimize potential noise impacts for surrounding businesses and residents. These measures will be implemented before piling activities begin. Throughout the duration of piling activities, a marine silt curtain will also be maintained as part of erosion and sediment control measures.

What to Expect



Timing

- Phase 1 activities: December 12 to Summer 2026.
- Phase 2 activities: January 2026 to Summer 2026.
- Phase 3 activities: Summer 2026 to 2027.



Hours of Work

- Monday to Friday: 7 AM to 5 PM
- Holiday Pause: December 24 to 28, 2025, and January 1, 2026



Traffic

- No vehicle or pedestrian traffic disruptions are expected.



Impacts

- Intermittent elevated noise during piling activities.
- Increased construction activity.
