Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment



We continue to progress on the Belleville Terminal Redevelopment Project. As part of ongoing construction work, a single lane alternating traffic setup will be implemented on Belleville Street on **Thursday, February 5, 2026, between the hours of 8 am and 3 pm.**

This work is required to remove associated crosswalks at Oswego Street and Belleville Street to accommodate the modified Black Ball ferry terminal entrance.

The work will be completed in two stages, with initial closure of the west bound traffic lane (shown in red), followed by reopening of the west bound lane and subsequent closure of the east bound traffic lane (shown in blue).
