Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment



We are pleased to share that work on the Belleville Terminal Redevelopment Project continues to progress.

As part of ongoing site mobilization, a sidewalk and parking lane closure (8 parking spaces) will be implemented on **October 24, 2025**. This includes the west-bound parking lane (8 parking spots) and the north sidewalk along Belleville Street between Oswego Street and Pendray Street. The closure will remain in place throughout the duration of the project to maintain public safety and accommodate modifications to the site entrance.

To ensure pedestrian safety, a new crosswalk will be installed at the Belleville Street and Pendray Street intersection, and a detour route will redirect pedestrians to the south sidewalk along Belleville Street, as shown in the attached map.

Timing

- October 24, 2025, to 2028.



Hours of Work

Traffic

- No change to Belleville Street vehicle traffic patterns
- Belleville Street west-bound parking lane closure (8 spots).
- Belleville Street north sidewalk closure.
- Pedestrian detour implementation.



Impacts

- Repositioned fencing and expanded construction site area.
- Removal of west-bound parking spaces along Belleville Street.
- Removal of trees and light posts from closed sidewalk area.
