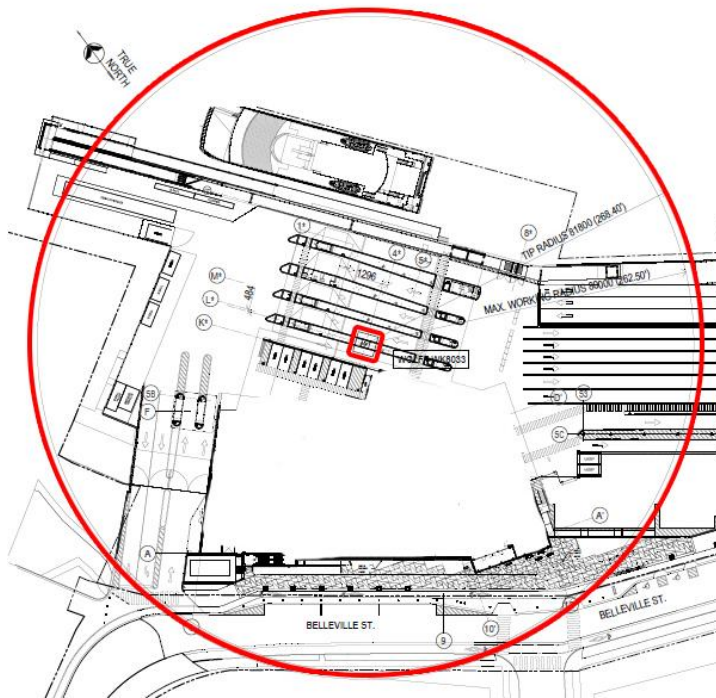

Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment



As construction of the Belleville Terminal progresses, **mobilization of a tower crane will begin on Friday, April 3, 2026**. The crane installation requires 4 days of work with extended working hours. Completion is expected by end of day Monday, April 6, 2026.

The tower crane is required to support upcoming construction activities, including the safe and efficient lifting of materials, equipment, and structural components within the active construction zone. The location of the crane (middle square) and the associated boom (arm) radius is shown in red in the diagram.

The tower crane will be approximately 58 meters tall and will have a working radius (boom length) of 80 meters. Once installed, the crane will remain on site for approximately 18 months.

Visual changes to the skyline and intermittent noise during crane assembly and operation may be noticeable; however, no impacts to public access or surrounding properties are anticipated.

Timing

- Delivery, mobilization and testing: April 3-6, 2026
- Crane will remain on site until End of 2027



Hours of Work

- Daily: 7 am to 7 pm



Traffic

- No anticipated traffic impacts

- Intermittent noise
