Construction Impact Notification Belleville Terminal Redevelopment



We are pleased to share that work on the Belleville Terminal Redevelopment Project continues to progress.

As part of site preparation tree removal operations are scheduled to take place at the northeast corner of Belleville Street and Oswego Street on **October 28, 2026**. This work is expected to last 1 day and will involve the removal of 17 trees to accommodate future work on the terminal. As part of the new terminal, new trees and vegetation will be planted.

There are no road or sidewalk closures, and traffic control personnel will be on-site to manage pedestrian and vehicle flow and ensure public safety with temporary pedestrian holds.

Timing

- October 28, 2025



Hours of Work

- 7 am to 5 pm



Traffic

- No vehicle impacts are expected, and traffic control personnel will be on-site.
- Sidewalk will remain open with pedestrian temporary holds expected.



Impacts

- Removal of 17 trees.
- Elevated noise levels during tree removal activities.
- Visual changes to the area.
