Overnight Work: Location of trailer removal

September 8, 8:00 pm – 1:00 am Overnight Work

A mobile crane will be mobilized to the Black Ball Ferry Terminal to remove a trailer, during a single night shift on September 8, in preparation for the construction of a future retaining wall along Belleville Street. To ensure the ongoing daytime operations of the ferry service and customs agencies, this work will take place at night.

September 11, 6:00 am – 7:00 pm Belleville and Pendray Street Closure

Ongoing concrete pours are planned as work on the building foundation progresses. This includes an upcoming pour that will require a temporary closure of Belleville and Pendray Streets to traffic in both directions due to the placement of a concrete pump and trucks. The concrete pour will take place within the working hours of 7:00 am-7:00 pm.

Detour routes for vehicle traffic, as well as pedestrians and cyclists, will be available via Oswego Street and Quebec Street.

What You Can Expect:

- Increased concrete truck and construction-related traffic
- Pump and concrete trucks to arrive at 6am and elevated noise from concrete trucks
- Traffic control personnel will be stationed to manage vehicle movements and ensure the safety of workers and the public
- Minimal levels of construction noise and light disturbance during overnight working hours
